#### NOTES:

On your day, your section is responsible for:

WATER JUGS – filling with water and ice and bringing out to field for all sessions outside. This must be done **BEFORE** the rehearsal start time.

“Fred” Sound System/Stand – setting up “Fred” and Stand he sits on (50 yard line) each morning of camp and taking down at the end of each session. “Fred” is stored in Mr. Cantrell’s office – where he will need to be charged each time after use.

POPSICLES –getting popsicles from the cafeteria freezer on time for breaks, hanging a trash bag on the fence, taking trash to the dumpster at the end of the day, cleaning the scissors and wiping the cooler bag out at the end of the day.

FIELD MARKERS/CLEARING FIELD – bringing up and properly placing markers on the field for all rehearsals. At the end of the day/night they must be brought and stored in the plastic storage unit under the tower. Also, the other members who are not getting the field markers should check the field/track for garbage, music, etc.

SECTION LEADERS – YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COORDINATING WHO IS DOING WHAT WITHIN YOUR SECTION.

**“FRED” AND MARKERS MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF BEFORE REHEARSAL START TIME!**  
Yes, this means coming in early. Being late because of your duty is a **NO-GO!**
